ORDER: -

The Director of Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, A.P. Hyderabad in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, has submitted proposals for sanction of Special Incentive to the new units to be set up in Apparel Export Park, Gundlapochampally Apparel Export Park, Visakhapatnam and Garment City Maheswaram (Ranga Reddy District) for an initial period of (3) years.

2. After careful examination of the proposal and keeping in view the representations of the Garment manufacturers, Government have decided to provide Special Incentive for partial reimbursement of electricity consumption charges to the new units to be set up on or after 1-11-2003, in the Apparel Export Parks Gundlapochampally, (Ranga Reddy District) for an initial period of 3 years subject to the following conditions.

1. The scheme of Special Power Incentive will be limited to an initial period of 3 years on a tapering basis i.e., 50%: 25%: 25% of the consumption charges to be reimbursed to the units concerned during 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years of operation, respectively.
2. The units should have installed and operated the sewing machines/accessory machines employing the skilled labour.
3. The units shall first pay the consumption charges to the agencies concerned and then furnish the claim to Development Commissioner, Apparel Export Park for reimbursement once in six months, (for period

from march to August and September to February), along with copies of power bills paid.

4. The units should have paid full amount to Andhra Pradesh Industrial Infrastructure Corporation towards land cost.
5. The units should have commenced the commercial production within a period of one year from the date of final allotment letter.

3. The Director Handlooms and Textiles and Development Commissioner for Apparel Export Parks, A.P. Hyderabad is hereby permitted to utilize the funds for partial reimbursement of consumption charges with effect from 1-11-2003, as per the guidelines laid down above, out of the funds allotted for Development of Apparel Parks under the following Head of Account.
